Men's Tournament Fund

All full golf members will be charged a fee of \$175 for the Men's Tournament Fund. This fee covers their entry to all events with the exception of the Member / Guests.

Weekday Members are not charged a tournament fund fee as they are not eligible to play in most events. The exceptions are Ryder Cup and the Member/Member, which will have a \$50 entry fee. Weekday Members are eligible to play in the Member/Guests at the regular price.


Handicap Information

Each individual is responsible for posting his score online or on the handicap computer for any round of golf played. We strongly suggest using the MyMGA App to post your score.

When posting scores, first follow the NET Double Bogey for Maximum Hole Score. Scores from other golf courses are also to be posted.

Maximum Hole Score for Handicap Purposes

The purpose of **MHS** is to eliminate unrealistic high hole scores. It sets a maximum score that a player can post on any hole, depending on the player's course handicap. For handicap purposes, you are required to adjust your score on a hole when it is higher than your maximum number you can post. There is no limit to the number of holes on which you can adjust your score. The maximum score for each hole played is limited to a net double bogey, calculated as follows:



Pace of Play

What is the NGC expected pace of play?

The expected pace of play is TWO hours or less for 9-holes and FOUR hours or less for 18-holes, no exceptions. If your group falls behind, please see below for a few ways to improve pace of play or allow the group behind to play through.

Main causes of slow play:

- 1. Not being ready when it is your turn.
 - a. Do not sit in the cart to wait your turn if your ball is nearby. While your cart companion is playing their shot you should determine yardage and club selection. When they are done playing, walk to your ball and play without delay.
 - b. Be ready on the green when it is your turn. Line up your putt while others are playing.
- 2. Park golf cart in an appropriate spot on the cart path next to the green on the way to the next tee. Keep score on the following tee box.
- 3. Not knowing the rules and etiquette
 - a. Not hitting provisional balls.
 - b. Exceeding the three-minute ball search rule.
 - c. Not keeping an eye on each other's golf ball.

Ways to speed up pace of play:

- 1. Hit when ready.
- 2. Keep your pre-shot routine short.
- 3. Keep up with the group in front of you. Your correct position on the course is immediately behind the group in front of you, not immediately in front of the group behind you.

 - There will be positioning weeks (Week 3, 6, & 8)
 - 1 vs 2 / 3 vs 4 / 5 vs 6 in the standings (seeding ties broken by most recent match)
- 100% handicap match play
- 9-hole matches $-\frac{1}{2}$ stroke on odd stroke differential
 - example: If a 10 handicap plays a 15 handicap -21/2 shots for 9 holes
- Points
 - \circ Win = 3 points
 - Tie = $1 \frac{1}{2}$ points
 - \circ Lose = 0 points
- If one player cannot make the tee time, the other player has the option to play alone or fill in a guest player from the substitute list, allowed 2 times MAX
 - o If you have a designated sub, this MAX does not apply to you
 - See email for further info
 - o Please find your own sub, do not call Jim until you have contacted the entire list
 - Try to find a sub within 5 strokes of your handicap
- No make-up matches play or forfeit

Dinner:

- The Wednesday night dinner menu will be sent out the Sunday before
 - Players are required to email <u>reservations@nissequoguegolf.com</u> if they will <u>NOT</u> be attending dinner by 5:00 pm on Tuesday
